Supplementary Sailing Instructions
5th July 2020

First Start: 1400.

Sign On

OTB entrants must sign on prior to leaving the shore and sign off immediately after returning to shore after the race.

Big Boats must sign on using VHF Ch. 73 20 minutes prior to the first scheduled start time. Please advise the boat name and number of people on board.

Courses:

Start: The start will be a line between an orange cylindrical 'pin' buoy and the mast of the committee start boat, identified by an orange flag, in the vicinity of D Buoy.

Finish: The finish will be a line between a black and white buoy and the mast of the committee boat, identified by a blue flag, in the start vicinity.

All marks of the course are rounding marks.

All boats crossing the channel must keep clear of shipping traffic. Check the schedule here <https://portinfo.darwinport.com.au/webx/#>

OTB boats are excluded from entering the shipping channel.

Harbour Series:

** The passing side of 'a' will be advised by displaying a red(p) or green(s) flag from the start boat not later than the first start preparatory signal.

Course for Division 1 & 3: Course 19

Start – a(p/s)– E(p) - No.5(s) E(s) a(p) – Finish (12.7nm)
as in the DSC Yearbook: page 58

Division 4: Duty Crew

Point Score races: Up to 2 races

- Div. 5 –L2 (Start, 1, 4, 1, Finish. All marks to port.)
Div. 6 - L2a (Start, 1a, 4, 1a, Finish. All marks to port.)
Div. 7 - L3 (Start, 1, 4, 1, 4, 1, Finish. All marks to port.)
Div. 8 - L2 (Start, 1, 4, 1, Finish. All marks to port.)

Marks

- 1 will be an orange cylindrical mark.
1a will be an orange cylindrical mark with a white band.
4 will be an orange cylindrical mark.

Starting Sequence:

The starting sequence will be as follows:

First Warning Signal 1355 hrs.

First start 1400 hrs

5 minutes before start: Warning signal, Divisional flag raised

4 Minutes before start: Sound signal, P flag raised

1 Minute before start: Sound signal, P flag lowered

Start: Divisional flag lowered, sound signal

Subsequent starts will be as per above with a five minute (Rule 26) sequence.

Starting order

Div. 1	Numeral Pennant 1:	1400
Div. 3	Numeral Pennant 3:	1405
Div. 5	Numeral Pennant 5:	1410
Div. 7 & 8	Numeral Pennant 7:	1415
Div. 6	Numeral Pennant 6:	1420

Note: In the case of no starters in any particular division the starting order will be adjusted.
