SAILING INSTRUCTIONS AMENDMENT 2 v 1

Date: 14th June 2020
Briefing: 0845hrs – at Rotunda
Start Time: 1000hrs

Safety:

Darwin Sailing Club recommends that OTB boats (Div 5, 6, 7) carry a waterproof VHF radio capable of receiving and transmitting on VHF Ch. 73 and that this radio be turned on for the duration of the event and until the boat has returned to shore, as well as a laminated chart of the competition course area.

Big Boats (Div 1, 3, 4) are required to meet the safety requirements of the Special Regulations for Category 7. Competitors are reminded that Northern Territory boating regulations require, in some areas, equipment in excess of the Australian Sailing Special Regulations.

Sign On

OTB entrants must sign on prior to leaving the shore and sign off immediately after returning to shore after the race.

Big Boats must sign on using VHF Ch. 73 20 minutes prior to the first scheduled start time. Please advise the boat name and number of people on board.

All marks of the course are rounding marks.

Courses:

Division 1 & 3:	Start, a(p/s), MA2(s), 8(p), 6(s), E(s) Finish
Division 4:	Start, a(p/s), MA2(s), 8 (p), 9(s), E (s), Finish
Division 5:	Start, a(p/s), MA1(s), E(s), Finish
Division 7:	Start, a(p/s), MA2(s), 8(p), 6(s), E(s), Finish
Division 6:	Start, a(p/s), D(s), E(s), D(s), E(s), Finish

The passing side of 'a' will be advised by displaying a red(p) or green+

(s) flag from the start boat not later than the first start preparatory signal.

Start: The start will be a line between an orange cylindrical 'pin' buoy and the mast of the committee start boat, identified by an orange flag, in the vicinity of D Buoy.

Finish: The finish will be a line between a black and white buoy and the mast of a committee boat, identified by a blue flag, in the start vicinity.

First Start: 1000 hrs

Starting Sequence:

The starting sequence will be as follows:

First start:

5 minutes before start: Warning signal, Divisional flag raised

4 Minutes before start: Sound signal, P flag raised

1 Minute before start: Sound signal, P flag lowered

Start: Divisional flag lowered, sound signal

Subsequent starts will be as per above with a five minute sequence with the divisional flag at the previous start time.

Warning signals:

Div. 1 & 4	Numeral Pennant 1:	1000
Div. 3	Numeral Pennant 3:	1005
Div. 7	Numeral Pennant 7:	1010
Div. 5	Numeral Pennant 5:	1015
Div. 6	Numeral Pennant 6:	1020

Notes:

1. In the case of no starters in any particular division the starting order will be adjusted.
2. Time limit: The time limit will be 1600 hrs.

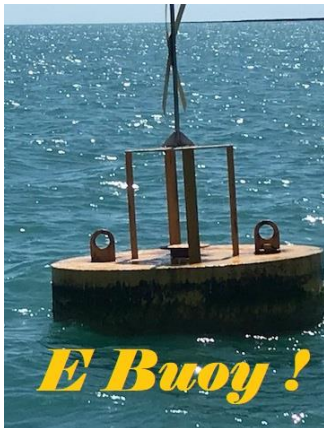
BBQ: The Sailing Committee is cooking a fundraising BBQ in conjunction with presentation. Please support them.

'a'	Orange cylindrical buoy with white stripe	upwind of start
MA2 – Port Lateral Buoy:		12° 29.342'S - 130° 49.443'E
MA1 – Starboard Lateral Buoy:		12° 28.780'S – 130° 48.710'E
No.6 – Port Lateral Buoy		12° 25.051'S – 130° 46.965'E
No.8 – Port Lateral Buoy:		12° 25.012'S - 130° 49.247'E
No.9 – Starboard Lateral Buoy:		12° 28.112'S - 130° 48.340'E
No.11 – Preferred Channel to Port (GRG)		12° 29.150'S - 130° 50.017'E
Submarine Buoy - Yellow Marker:		12° 28.020'S - 130° 47.58'E
"E" Buoy – Yellow Mark:		12° 25.560'S - 130° 48.80'E
